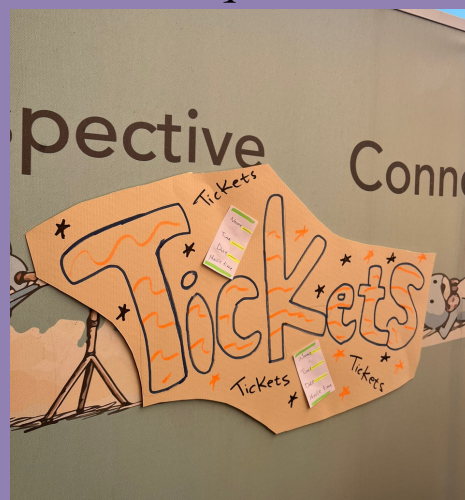
ALL ABOUT MY TOWN

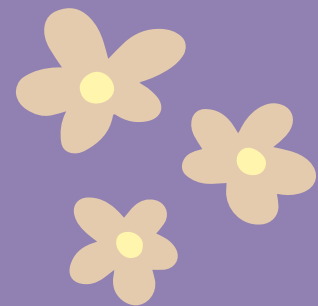


BACK TO LEARNING
